

BIG BUCKS HIGH ROLLERS are a skater-owned-and-run roller derby league. Born on the 4 July 2011, we are a team of like minded skaters, referees, NSOs and volunteers. After taking a break from competing in British Champs last year, the 'green machine' have returned, feeling stronger than ever. ROLLER DERBY 101







A game is made up of a number of individual 'jams', each lasting up to two minutes. Each of the two teams will put five skaters onto the track at a time; one 'jammer' (designated scoring player) and four 'blockers'. One blocker from each team can be designated as the 'pivot'.

Play begins with the blockers, from both teams skating in a mixed formation known as the 'pack'. The two jammers start behind the pack and must try to get through and out the front of the pack - the first to do so earns 'lead jammer' status. After this initial pass, the jammer races around the track and through the pack for a second time. Each opponent they pass, legally and in bounds, they earn a point!

The **blockers** will be trying to help their own jammer get through the pack as well as simultaneously trying to stop the opposing jammer from passing them.

Jammers may continue to race around the track and score points for up to two minutes, or until the lead jammer calls off the jam (by tapping their hands to their hips). When this happens, the referees will blow four short blasts of the whistle before we start over again with the next jam. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins!



JAMMER: The jammer wears a star on their helmet. They are the only skater who can score points and they must break through the pack once and complete a lap before being able to score points.

PIVOT: The pivot wears a vertical stripe on their helmet. They are a special kind of blocker who can receive a star pass from a jammer. When this happens, the pivot becomes the jammer during that jam.

BLOCKERS: They play vital offensive and defensive roles, helping their jammer get through the pack while simultaneously working together to block the opposing team's jammer.

PENALTIES: Referees communicate penalties with one blow of the whistle, then call out the offending skater by colour and number, followed by their penalty.

PENALTY BOX: The penalty box is a seated area outside of the track. Skaters sent off for penalties must enter the penalty box safely by skating in any direction outside of the track boundary. They must re-enter the track behind the pack once the penalty time (30 seconds) has been served.

If a skater receives 7 penalties they 'foul out' of the game, this means that they will not be permitted to play for the rest of the game.

POWER JAM: When a jammer is sent to the penalty box, the opposing team have a huge opportunity to rack up some points without giving any away. This is called a 'power jam'. If both jammers are sent off, the jammer that entered the box first is allowed back on to the track as soon as the second jammer reaches the box.


